WEIGHT OF SCHOOL BACK PACKS

It may be worth checking the weight (and contents!) of school back packs, particularly now the swimming kit season is about to start. It is recommended that children's bags should weigh no more than 10% of their body weight; carrying heavier bags, even for short periods, can contribute to back problems as they grow up. If children carry their own things into school or breakfast club, then that will help them remember what they need to bring home. If their bag is too heavy for them, then they need to choose what to take out.

INTERNET SAFETY DAY - 11 FEBRUARY 2025

Top tips from Warwickshire County Council:

- Set up an account for each user on your PC at home, make yourself the administrator and password protect each user. You can do this in the 'control panel'
- Add a screen saver protected by a password so that if you leave your PC for 5 minutes you will have to enter a password. You can do this in the 'control panel'
- Encourage children to use devices in a public part of the house, not their bedroom
- Use the family settings on games consoles.
- Set your favourite search engine to do 'safe searches', making sure that a search returns content suitable for all ages; eg for Google, click on search settings on the homepage and then enable moderate or strict filtering
- Discuss and agree with your children your own family code for internet use and encourage them to tell you if they see or hear anything they don't understand or that makes them feel sad or worried
- Report any concerns to the police
